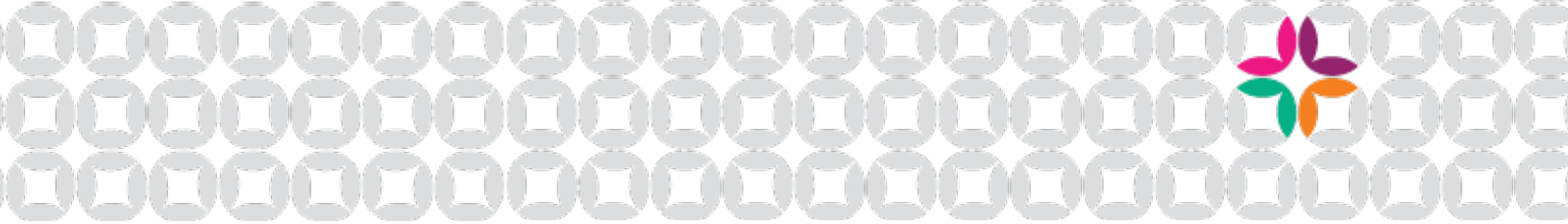

NPC does not recommend this program be hosted in late spring or at the end of an officer term.

Prior to Applying:
