



2021 College Panhellenic Academy Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q. In the past, we have registered our number of attendees and provided their names afterwards. Can we do that again?

A. This year we ask that you register your attendees in FS Central once you know their names.

Q. Is there a discount for multiple registrations?

A. There is not a discount available at this time but we do offer scholarships to assist with affordability (see next question).

Q. Our College Panhellenic is interested in registering participants but we aren't sure we have the budget to do so. Are scholarships available?

A. Due to a generous gift to the National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) from Zeta Tau Alpha, scholarships are available for this year's event. Scholarship applications were due by Oct. 11, 2020. Recipients will be notified in late October.

Q. Is there a late registration fee?

A. The cost to attend 2021 College Panhellenic Academy is US\$99/person. Registering by Dec. 7, 2020, will guarantee that a gift box filled with fun items to use during the event is sent to your physical mailing address.

Q. How can we access the virtual event?

A. Each attendee will be emailed specific instructions to access the event through our event app. Please make sure to check your email frequently. A mobile device or computer with an accessible camera will be necessary to participate in the virtual event.

Q. I want to attend but cannot attend the entire event. Is my attendance required at every session?

A. While we hope you can join us for each of the sessions, we understand if you can't! You are welcome to join the sessions that best fit your schedule but encourage participation in all education offered.

Q. What is the attire for the virtual event?

A. While there's no official dress code for the virtual College Panhellenic Academy experience, please be aware we will ask attendees to turn on their cameras for the duration of the event. You should plan to dress for an online learning environment where you will interact with NPC leadership and volunteers as well as your peers.

Q. I was hoping to meet with vendors at the event. Will attendees be given instructions for how to contact NPC partners?

A. Yes! Through our event app you will have an opportunity to "e-meet" the various NPC partners, learn more about them and ask any questions that you may have.
